This letter is being sent to all students enrolled in at least one Advanced Placement (AP) course during the 2017-18 academic year and, accordingly, have the potential to take the corresponding AP exam this spring. The time to register for all AP exams has arrived. We are pleased to announce that the AP exams listed on the following page are available for students to take. Each exam has a full price cost of \$94; however, the State of Indiana does subsidize much of the cost for math and science exams, leaving only \$9 as the student cost for each of these exams. The State will subsidize the cost for the English exams for 11th and 12th grade students, leaving a \$9 fee for those exams as well. ***The subsidized cost is for students currently enrolled in the courses listed.*** Additionally, students who receive either free or reduced lunch through the federal subsidy program qualify for an exception of fees on all non-English, non-math, and non-science AP exams, leaving a student no cost for each non-English, non-math, and non-science exam. In order to register for an AP exam, please fill out the following page and return it, with payment, during the student's lunch hour the week of **February 19th**. The deadline for registration is **Monday, February 26, 2018.**

If the student will be taking two exams on the same day, please indicate whether s/he will bring a sack lunch from home or order a boxed lunch from the school cafeteria. If the student plans on taking exams that are schedule at the same time, the student will take the exam with an *asterisk* next to the title on the alternate date listed at the bottom of the spreadsheet.

Some students may need special accommodations during testing such as those identified in a 504 plan or due to extenuating circumstances. Please notify during registration if you have any special needs.

Students must attend one pre-administration session to fill out all of the necessary paperwork. These sessions will take place in Cafeteria B on **Wednesday April 11th (PM only), Thursday April 12th, Friday April 13th, Tuesday April 17th, Wednesday April 18th, and Thursday April 19th** before school 7:00 – 7:30 a.m. and after school at 2:30 – 3:30 p.m.
