1:1/BYOD Initiative 2017-18

Greetings Valparaiso High School Families,

This information is for parents/guardians of all VHS students for the 2017-2018 school year.

Program Snapshot

A 1:1 device is a daily required element for students in grades 9-12. The following program will be implemented for 2017-18:

- Freshman: VCS supplied Chromebook (required device; no option to bring their own device)
- Sophomores: VCS supplied Dell or HP laptop.
- Juniors/Seniors: Open policy for students to bring their own device to school according to their subject area interest, preferred customizations and desired *computing power. Any student not opting for the BYOD option will be required to borrow a VCS issued device from available inventory and all repair/replacement fees will in effect.

**Device must meet minimum device requirement as listed below.*

All VHS issued devices for the school year will be available for pickup on the tech days listed below. When the student is issued the device the student must sign a liability waiver and will be responsible for any and all damages that occur with that device.

VHS Tech Days

In order to provide parents and students with ample time to adjust to Valparaiso High School's 1:1 environment, we will be offering four different opportunities (open house format) for families to come to VHS to pick up their school issued devices, bring their own devices to connect to the school WIFI network, and/or meet with the Best Buy Geek Squad. In addition, members of the VHS Tech Department will also be available to assist with any other problems. The dates and times of those Tech Days are as follows: Tuesday **July 25th** from 9-11am, Thursday **July 27th** from 6-8pm, Tuesday **August 1st** from 6-8pm and Thursday **August 3rd** from 9-11 am at the Valparaiso High School Media Center.

Additional Information

If you are considering having your student bring their own device, please remember the minimum system requirements for next school year. Regardless of what device a student chooses to use, all VHS students will be required to adhere to the Acceptable Use Policy at all times. Although cell phones can be educational tools in some settings, they are **NOT** considered proper BYOD Devices at VHS.

Minimum Device Requirements

1. Device with keyboard which also includes a Chromebook (must be capable of running most recent version of Chrome OS).
2. Must be Windows 7 or later; Mac 10.8 or later; or Chrome OS
 - Linux OS not recommended
3. 4 GB of RAM or more.
4. 256 GB HD for Windows or More / 16 GB HD for Chromebook
5. HD Webcam
6. Chrome Browser Installed
7. iPads and/or tablets are **not** recommended unless they have an attachable full size keyboard and are capable of running a chrome browser and interacting comfortably with Canvas, and Google Apps (Drive, Docs, Sheets, etc).
8. Antivirus Software:
 - Student can download the Avast Education version at no cost

9. Required and Suggested Applications and/or Accessories- see information in the [BYOD/1:1](#) initiative document on the VHS website
10. A protective case is recommended and will be allowed to be carried from class to class. Most laptops do not include a case so please plan to purchase a case or have a backpack with a laptop compartment.

11. Items to consider:

- Laptop weight and size (carried all day to classes).
- Battery life (must last the student throughout the school day).
- Is there a warranty if the device is damaged? Is it covered under homeowner's insurance?

12. VCS is required by law to use a filter on our internet. Installing an additional filter on a BYOD laptop can cause issues for the student while they are using their laptop at school.

13. If a problem occurs with the device at home or at school, a loaner device from VCS is available for a maximum of 10 school days per semester. A record will be kept by the media center specialist. Please [see VCS Loaner Device Policy](#) for more details.
